

General Rules

- EKSS IS A PEDIGREED SHOW in order to show as a breed, you must have registration papers the day of the first show you are attending. Registrations papers must be verified by the EKSSS before the show. If registration papers are not provided the animal will be placed in the crossbred division. Breed classifications as set forth by the NSR, CPS & Berkshire Association will be enforced and verified by a NSR representative and/or EKSSS Committee.
- All shows are open to all youth who are 19 years of age and under as of 1/1/17 (subject to ID check)
- . Showmanship Divisions will be:
 - Seniors 14 & older
 - o Intermediates 10-13
 - Juniors 6-9
 - Pee Wee 5 & under
- No minimum age for pedigreed and crossbred class exhibitors BUT MUST BE CAPABLE OF SHOWING ENTIRELY UNASSISTED
- Hogs must be owned & shown by the exhibitor WITH NO ASSISTANCE. (no tag along)
- To participate in showmanship each exhibitor must enter minimum one hog in the show this applies to ALL
 exhibitors.
- Hogs shown by breed barrows & gilts shown together
- Breeds: Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, Berkshire, Chester/Landrace, Spot/Poland, Light Crossbred & Dark Crossbred
- If fewer than 5 head of any breed are entered, they will show as an AOB. If fewer than 5 head are entered as AOB, they will show in a crossbred class.
- Number of head per class 15 or less (approx)
- Showmanship exhibitors max 15 per class (approx)
- Showmanship classes are first at all shows no gate cuts and classes must be posted.
- Hogs tracked by Kansas 4-H tag or series tag
- All shows are judged as "Prospect Shows" & left to the judge's opinion.
- No maximum or minimum weight requirements
- Show committee's do have the option for a 10 lb weigh back and reserve the right to enforce at any or all shows.
- Entry fees for series MEMBERS-\$11.00 per head pre-entered or \$16.00 late entry
- NON-SERIES MEMBERS \$22.00 PER HEAD PRE-ENTRY OR \$32.00 LATE ENTRY
- Series Annual Membership Fee \$20.00 for ALL exhibitors
- All ties for yearend awards will be broken by tie breaker rules put in place by EKSSS committee.
- . Members must attend a minimum of 6 of the 11 shows to qualify for drawing prizes
- If hog is called back to ring for breed or championship drive and is a no show, all points for that pig from that date/show will be forfeited.
- EXHIBITORS AND SERIES MEMBERS ONLY ALLOWED IN HOLDING RING.
- CLAIRIFICATION:
 - SHOWMANSHIP: Class exhibitors must drive hogs owned by them and designated as their own specific entry in regular class. Exhibitors are allowed to switch showmanship hogs as the series progresses but still must be designated to them and not another series or family member.
 - MARKET HOGS:
 - Once a hog is entered in an exhibitors name, it may only be shown by that exhibitor throughout the balance of the series
 - Once a hog is entered under a certain breed or crossbred designation, it must continue to be shown under same stated breed throughout the series, unless hog reclassified by EKSSS committee.
- FAILURE TO FOLLOW SERIES RULES AND GUIDELINES IS CAUSE FOR DISQUALIFICATION OF EXHIBITOR/HOG AND ELIMINATION OF ALL SERIES POINTS.

Swine Show

- 1. All Swine must have a 4-H ID tag or series tag & ear notch by May 6, 2017.
- 2. EKSSS IN 2017 WILL BE A PEDIGREE SHOW- in order to show as a breed you must have registration papers in the exhibitors name no later than May 7, 2017. Registration papers must be verified by the EKSSS on or before this date. If registration papers are not provided all points accumulated to that point will be void and the animal will be placed in the crossbred division from that point forward. Breed classifications as set forth by the NSR, CPS, & Berkshire Association will be enforced and verified by the NSR representative and/or EKSSS committee.
- 3. Swine will be shown by breeds. Gilts and barrows will show together and will be separated by weights. All swine MUST be weighed upon arrival. All shows are judged as "Prospect Shows" & left to the judge's opinion.
- 4. All males must be castrated.
- 5. Failure to pre-enter classes by April 21 will constitute a late registration fee of \$16.00. Entries must carry a postmark date of April 21 or earlier to qualify for regular entry. Show Day entries will close at 10:00AM. Absolutely **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- 6. Number of head per class will be maximum 15 per class.
- 7. All exhibitors must register with the show committee on Saturday May 6th from 5:30PM-7:00PM or on show day between 8:00AM-10:00AM.
- 8. Pens will be available on a first come first serve basis. Pens will cost \$5 each. Due to limited space exhibitors may choose to show off trailer.
- 9. Judge's decision will be final and they will place animals shown on their quality compared to the breed standard.
- 10. Swine originating in Kansas must be free of clinical signs of infestations or contagious disease. A negative Pseudorabies and Brucellosis test are <u>not</u> required for Kansas origin swine. No health certificate or blood test is needed in 2017 for any swine project. All swine originating out of State or purchased out of state need to follow state guidelines and must have a health certificate within 30 days and have a negative blood test or originate from a disease free herd. **Health papers required for out of state entries only.**
- 11. No minimum or maximum weights.
- 12. Hogs must be owned & shown by exhibitor WITH NO ASSISTANCE. (no tag-along)
- 13. Series Annual Entry fee \$20.00 for All Exhibitors
